



We are excited that you will be performing at this year's Music & Market in Spring Grove, MN!

Our summer series is a favorite event of our community and is attended by people of all ages. In addition to your live music, each week also has a non-profit organization serving the food as a fundraiser for their group. We have a farmers market that also takes place each week in the park. New this year is that the market will be in the park and we also plan to have a few yard games for people of all ages. Music and food is 5-7 p.m., farmers market is 4-7 p.m. It will be a fun and activity-filled evening in the park!

Location and time:

- Music begins at 5:00 p.m., please be set-up and ready to go by 5:00 p.m. FYI – The bell at Trinity church (located right next to the park) will ring at 5:00 p.m. and again at 6:00 p.m. with a longer song, feel free to take a break during this song.
- Music & Market takes place in Viking Memorial Park (115 E. Main Street). You will be setting up in the gazebo in the park. Please park on Maple Drive (one way street on the “back-side” of the park). There is angled parking on the left-hand side of Maple Drive. You may park there or if you want to be closer to the gazebo for unloading, you may *temporarily* park on the right-hand side of the road parallel to the park with your hazards on; when finished unloading, please move your vehicle to a regular parking space. If you need to pull-up on the lawn to unload, please call Jana at City Hall, 507-498-5221 and she will come to the park and direct you where it is safe to drive. Thanks for your cooperation!

Details about the gazebo:

- There is a timer (with an off/on switch) in the gazebo. The box is labeled and the switch to turn it on is under the box itself.
- It has four 110V double receptacles (ability to plug in eight things) and one 50 Amp 240V with ground.

Inclement weather:

- Music & Market will take place regardless of the weather, but the location will be moved to our inclement weather location – the front room at the American Legion (104 W. Main Street).
- The Chamber will watch the forecast and decide by 2:00 p.m. if the Music & Market event will move to the Legion.
- Please make sure that we have a cell phone number for the person in charge of your group so that we may readily contact them with updates in the case of inclement weather.

Payment:

The evening of your performance, a Chamber Board Member will give you your payment in the form of a check made out to the name indicated on the sign-up form.
